#### **President's Report**

Jobs vary from line-marking Areas A, B, C and D on the Saturday. While this is being done another group of volunteers is working in the Pit Lane Garages putting together the Flags onto poles ready to be taped around the bins and put in place in the various Areas.

As well as this, we have a team of people getting ready to fill the 2000 Shannons Bags with The Preserves and other brochures . Then there's decorating the CMC Garage and CMC Markets Garages and the list goes on and on.

On the Sunday we desperately need at least <u>one or two members from each Club</u> to act as Marshalls in Areas A, B, C, D and E, to ensure all vehicles are correctly spaced in their allocated areas.

We will need assistance in the CMC Garage on Sunday selling Raffle Tickets, Merchandise and handing out SSC Medallions. Just an hour of your time on the Sunday will assist us greatly.

Closing date for the Concours is fast approaching (21st July) and this year we initiate the **Bryan Horne Trophy for Best Australian Built/Assembled Vehicle**. We're delighted that Bryan's wife Jennifer Horne will be attending and bringing the fabulous Holden Convertible to Shannons Sydney Classic—it will sit on Pit Lane alongside the Concours vehicles.

Sorting through the paperwork and computer items which we now have from Julie Williams' family is taking some time. It is a well-known fact that you have no idea how much one person did for you until they are gone. If ever there was a case of this fact you need look no further than the CMC, the ACMC and several clubs Jules did everything Secretarial wise for. Unbelievable the effort that lady put in for the old car movement over the years.

I have taken on the task of keeping the relatively new Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS) operational and it is a HUGE job for an old computer luddite like me. The number of vehicles reached 1,850 just recently plus the flow of annual renewals is constant. A far cry from the rather optimistic estimates by some of 10,000 back in 2016 as we started the CVS off but a significant number all the same. Interesting how many new applications are for vehicles "converting" from the Historic scheme (HVS) to the newer CVS. May be something to do with the number of cars being picked up by RMS Inspectors at events. I know of eight from one event alone. You may be aware that at least one club has been taken off the approved list for HVS by the RMS after multiple transgressions. So please be warned that it is happening and will catch up with some clubs soon.

Soon we begin the campaign to ensure that the 60 day logbook system is made permanent at the end of the second two year trial period.

We will start it off in the near future to ensure that the RMS etc do not leave it until the last moment and simply extend the trial once more.



# GUIDELINES FOR CLUB COMMITTEE HANDOVER AND HOW TO DOWNLOAD MINUTES & MAGAZINES

These details should be kept with your Club Secretary or Public Officer and handed to the new Committee following your AGM or at a time immediately following any Committee changes.

The Committee of the CMC has identified some issues around club contact details, which are stored on our database, as being incorrect. This means some emails aren't getting to some of our clubs.

If you aren't getting emails from us, it's possible that your details are incorrect OR your computer is treating our emails as SPAM. To overcome this, you need to check your **Junk Mail Folder** and if you find an email in there from us you will need to right click on the message, then click on **Junk Email** and select **Add sender to safe senders list**, this should overcome the SPAM issue.

We are aware that at the time of the CMC Affiliation Renewal each year (31<sup>st</sup> December) your Club's details may well be correct. However, your contact details and/or the details of your Executive Committee may change during the year for various reasons.

In order to assist your club with handover to a new Committee, or Public Officer, we offer a few suggestions below. We sincerely hope that your kind assistance with this issue will alleviate some of the discrepancies which appear each year in our records and will allow us to keep you informed of important issues in a timely manner.

In order that RMS records for your Club are kept up to date, the Council suggests that the details regarding any Executive Committee changes should also be advised to the Roads & Maritime Service as soon as possible. (*This service has been relocated from Grafton. Please call the RMS or visit their website for details.*) This is especially important if your Club has vehicles on HVS or CVS. Failure to inform them may result in an application for registration being refused.

You must also advise NSW Fair Trading (13 32 20) of your Public Officer and/or address changes.

## Guidelines Note: Affiliation Renewals are due on 31<sup>st</sup> December each year and close 31st March each year (CMC Constitution states that clubs will be unfinancial if Renewal is not received by 31/3)
