## BEHIND THE SCENES GUIDED TOUR - FREE WITH ADMISSION

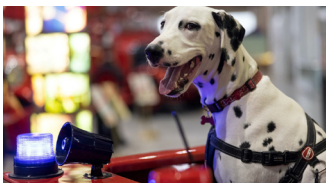
