Presidents Report – T Thompson

Terry reported, that as he was running CVS & Club Registrar from his home, he had spoken to his home insurer of this activity. The insurance company made him aware that he should not invite these people into his home. Registrars should be aware and seek clarification from their own insurers.

VSWG- Their Co-Chair retired and has left the committee; they are looking for another. Discussions on VSI 53. Also, on VSI6 and the 20% horse power increase needing revision, perhaps incorporating a sliding scale on engine size.

New Document from TfNSW clarifying application and use of Log Books.

HCCIWG- Are asking where are the new number plates?

On November 1st 2022, NSW Governments Unattended Property Act came into force. This concerns Class A vehicles (eg: cars, caravans, boats and trailers) in public spaces. Registered vehicles can be issued a notice to move after 28 days, & impounded after another 15 days. Unregistered vehicles parked in the same place can be given notice after 15 days and impounded after another 3 days. If parked obstructing access or posing a safety risk, car may be removed immediately. In all cases there is a \$660 fine, and if uncollected councils may sell the vehicle.

Marrickville SNSW has been noted issuing U plates for CVS. If you have been issued these plates, please speak to SNSW to have them corrected.
