# Presidents Report – T Thompson

CVS update: 1927 vehicles as at 28/3/23.

Terry reported about several meetings he has recently attended:

- Historic & Classic requested exemption for older cars re seat belts to be compliant – No, anchorage points not always appropriate.

- Number plates passed and awaiting head of department to sign off. New plates can be exchanged for old plates, however no need to change.

- Period Options and Accessories almost ready to be sent to committee for comments. Invalid lists are still on TfNSW website.

- Tractor conditions – No change, all comments are simply rumors.

- Family Trusts can own HVS/CVS cars, but clubs MUST include "Family Trusts can be members" in their Constitution to allow this.

- Reg Star – new computer system to look at electronic pink slips.

- No restrictions for Conditional Registrations in regional areas.

- Request for All Conditional registration information to be on one website, rather than spreading information over TfNSW, Service NSW & NSW Gov.

- OL3 Certificate not applicable to CVS. Unless on Club run, MUST fill out Log Book.

- Engineers certificate must be on the Certificate of Operations.
