4. PRECIS OF COMMITTEE MEETING held 8th November 2023.

T. Thompson reported: All 9 members were present.

Allan Drane, Ian & Catherine Andersen were also in attendance.

- * **Business Arising:** Ian is stepping back in as the Webmaster for CMC. Kay is stepping down as Treasurer, with Allan Drane having been nominated for tonight's AGM to take on the role.
- Secretary Report: Received numerous emails, phone calls, etc. Main topics raised, as usual, were CVS & HVS related. 3 letters had been sent out to clubs re their members behaviour at the SSC 2023. 1 written response and 1 phone call have been received. Still receiving some paper magazines, CMC is no longer collecting these, and asks clubs to check with their editors to ensure they are stopped. It is a State requirement that clubs are to send their hardcopy magazine or electronic magazines to the State Library. Details are in the December Preserve.
- * **President's Report**: Current CMC CVS numbers are 2131. More meetings are now being held through Teams. VSWG held their meeting 21/11, report on this shortly. Road Safety Advisory Council meeting is due to be held 6/12, first since the new government came to power.
- * **Treasurers Report:** Kay will give her report soon, with the yearly report included in the AGM to be held after the General Meeting.
- * Judging Pool: Terry B gave a wonderful account of the Cronulla RSL MegFest day. He will give more in his report shortly.
- * **NMHD**: Next date is 19/5/24. The Committee decided on the 2 winners of our Annual Trophies, to be awarded soon.
- * **SSC**: One club has already pre-paid for their 20 tickets for next year's show. Tickets go on sale at the January Meeting and allocations are not done before that meeting. Club limits of 20 display vehicles in areas to remain at present. Limit of 5 for Pit Lane Anniversaries, they will have their own stickers printed for next year. Issues with ARDC grossly overspending on security.
- Website/Facebook: Website has been updated. Bruno is stepping down as Webmaster, with Ian Andersen holding up his hand for the role. Thank you, Ian. Boyd reported that Facebook numbers were over 183,000 for the last 4 weeks.
- * AHMF & RSF: One member unable to attend due to a death in the family. Still working on other states, WA- possible, Tas- not likely, NT- still sorting it out. We were informed that there are over 312,000 vehicles over 30 years of age registered in NSW/ACT. Only 80,000 + are on the HVS & CVS schemes. Discussion re AHMF looking at organising a public liability policy for Historic Car Clubs. Notified that one association pays \$20 per member. Next meeting

17/1/24, with the AGM in September in Adelaide.
